Exercise.



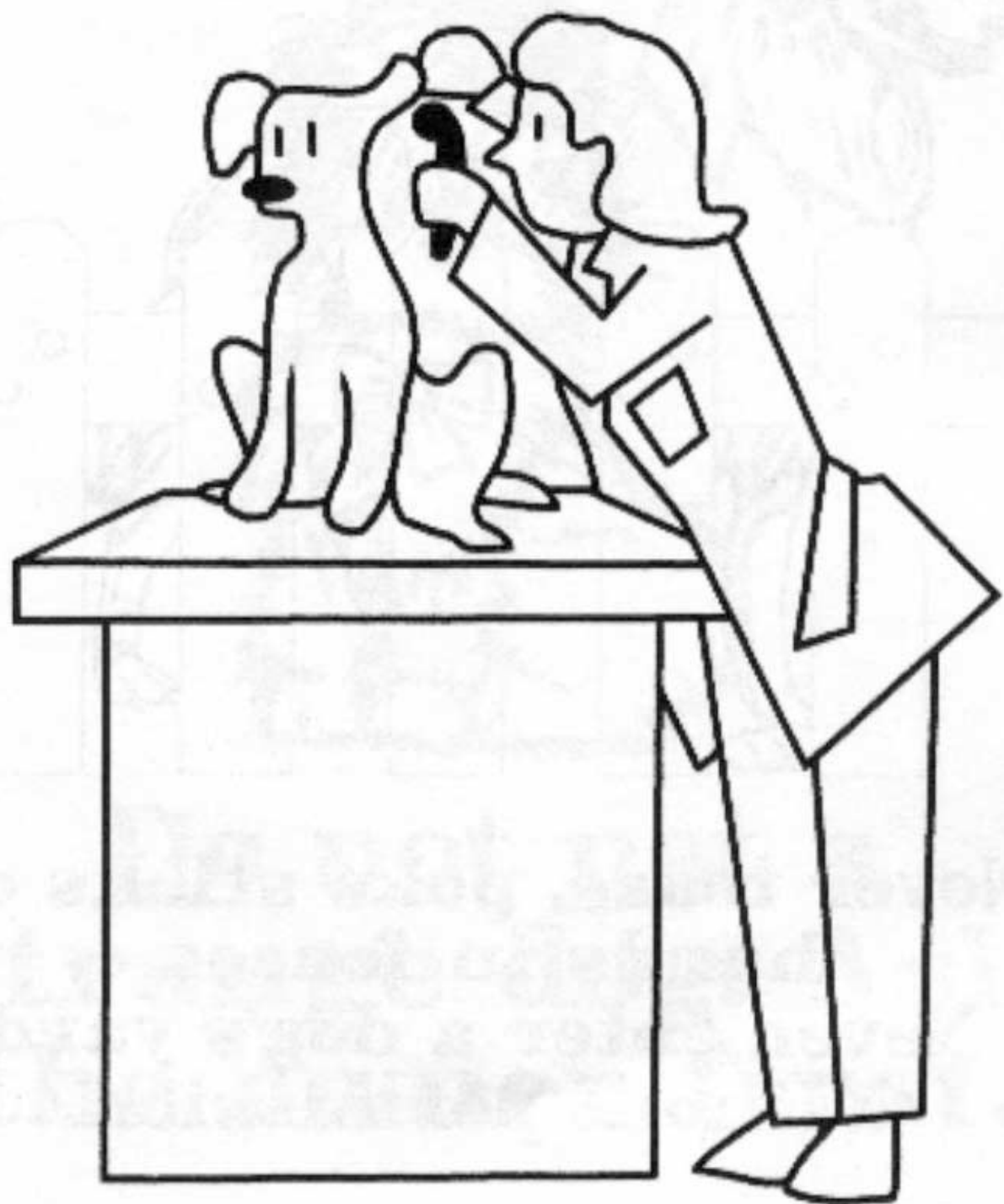
**Play with your dog

your dog.

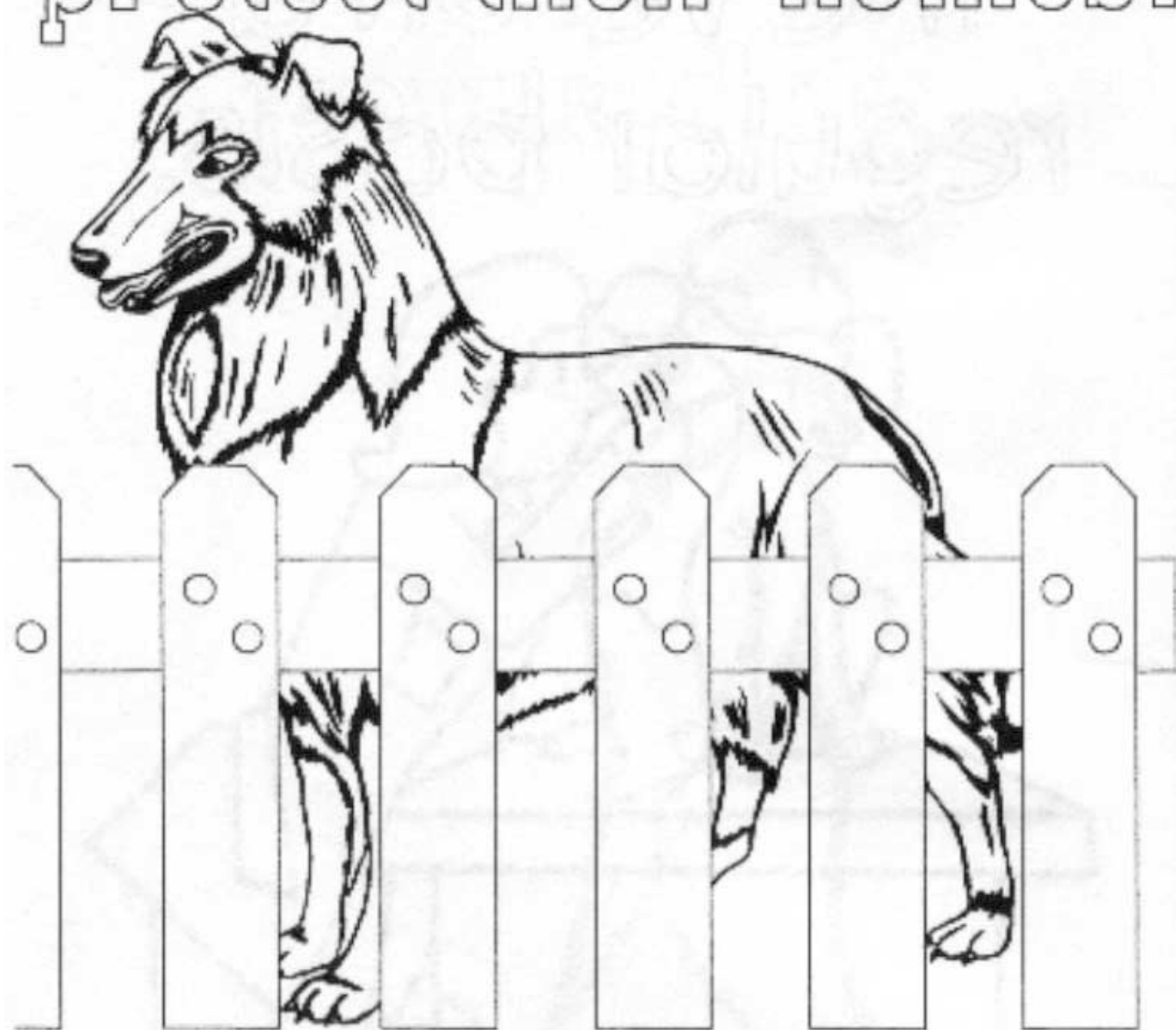


It's the Law!
